

The Backup Workflow Card

weddingphotographytips.com, keep it in the card wallet

ON THE DAY (PRINTABLE)

[] Both bodies set to write duplicates to both slots, verified with a test frame and a chimp of BOTH cards, the week before and again in the car.

[] Cards formatted in the camera that will use them, before the day, never on it.

[] Full cards go in the second bag or a zipped pocket on your body, never back into the card wallet with the blanks, and the wallet never sits unattended.

[] Swap cards at natural breaks with margin remaining, dinner, the lull before the entrance, not at 2 percent during the toasts.

[] If a card errors mid day: stop using it, do not format it, do not retry it in another body. Label it, pocket it, switch to fresh, recovery happens at a desk, not a reception.

[] Batteries and cards live in the same pockets every wedding, so your hands know where everything is in a dark room.
